#Tell Your Story Campaign

Tell Your War Story

End Impunity Organization in Sudan is launching a campaign under the banner 'TELL YOUR STORY'. This campaign concerns people who have been victimized by the continuous human rights violations in Sudan since the December Revolution 2018-2019, and crimes committed prior to this date, including during the current war from April 15, 2023 onward. Many crimes have been committed in Sudan, particularly atrocity crimes prosecutable under the Rome Statute of the International Criminal Court (ICC).

Thousands of Sudanese civilians were brutally murdered, displaced, and fall victims to many crimes that may amount to crimes against humanity, war crimes, and genocide.

We want to hear about your war story, if you're affected by the war or endured human right violations since the establishment of the the ICC, tell us your experience.

On May 24, 2023, ICC Prosecutor Karim Khan announced the launch of advanced evidence submission platform. This new online platform provides a more accessible avenue for victims and witnesses to access the ICC and provides their stories of violations. You may submit the information directly to the Office Of the Prosecutor on the page called 'OTPLink',

INSTRUCTIONS:

I. Provide the Type of VIOLATIONS:

- Murder, Extermination, Torture, Enslavement;
- Rape, Sexual Violence, and Sexual Slavery, abduction of Women and Minor Girls, Sexual Trafficking and Forced Prostitution;
- Forced Displacement, Kidnapping, If Possible Provide the Names of those Forcibly Disappeared;
- If you were Expelled from your Land or Home and your Possessions are taken by force, tell details of possessions, and the location of the house;
- Mention any Other Inhumane Acts.

II. Who Violated Your Rights?

- Tell who violated your rights as a human-being and committed the crimes, for example Rapid Support Forces Militia, Sudan Armed Forces, Security Agencies, Persons in Leadership Positions and Individuals belonging to an Organized Group. Who Planned, Financed, and Implemented Atrocity Crimes.

III. Date and Time of Incident:

State the date and time the incident or incidents took place.

The campaign team will analyze all information, verify their credibility, and truthfulness of incidents occurred.

Your story will not be shared with third parties or the media, Final destination of your story will be the Office of the Prosecutor of the International Criminal Court.

The perpetrators are destined to face justice and criminal prosecution, redress for the victims.
